 - Care for higher risk patients
 - Referrals for screenings such as mammograms, digital rectal exam to evaluate prostate health, DEXA scans, lung screenings for cancer and any other referrals made to any specialty.
 - Mental health services
 - Psychology
 - Mental health counselor
 - Nutritional supplies and supplements
 - Case Management & Supportive Services
 - Arrange transportation to medical appointments to the clinic
 - Interpreter services scheduled when needed.
- Primary care for transgender and non-binary people, men and women
