The US has the <u>highest</u> rate of teen pregnancy in the developed world (excluding Russia) at 57/1000 births.

Most of the countries with the lowest teen pregnancy rates are in Western Europe.

Ex. Netherlands
-rate of 4/1000

-compulsory relationship and sex education from age 4. One of the first concepts taught is consent.

Some teen pregnancy rate factors:

- -societal attitudes toward teen sex
- -quality and consistency of sex ed
- -socioeconomic inequality

The UN, UNESCO, and WHO all support comprehensive sex ed.
